Work Environment Requirements: The physical demands for this position involve the ability to maneuver in an industrial fabrication environment as needed to oversee the accomplishment of work. Requires extensive walking, standing, climbing, crouching, twisting and stooping. Requires lifting of heavy steel and some assistance with heavy equipment. Work is predominately performed outside or on board barges in all weather conditions. Use of tools requires manual dexterity and fine motor movement. The work environment for this job is demanding and potentially hazardous due to work on or inside barges as well as travel around the ship yard. Must also be able to work long hours and work any day of the week at any time of the day as required to meet customer needs, business objectives and to achieve delivery of service deadlines.
